



Instructions for Navigating an Okta Certification Practice Exam

Thanks for choosing to take an Okta Certification Practice Exam as part of your preparation for certification.

You have made an excellent decision. Feedback is provided during Okta Certification Practice Exams to enhance your learning experience. After answering each question, you will be given the opportunity to see the correct answer or answers and receive feedback on the **YES/NO** decisions you made. This document contains instructions on how to use the **Feedback** feature in order to see your responses, the correct **YES/NO** decisions we expect you to make, as well as the correct answer or answers to each question.

Responding to questions

Once you have finished reading the stem of a question, click **SHOW ME AN OPTION**.

A single option will be presented to you. Your task every time you see an option is to simply make a **YES** or **NO** decision, representing whether the option is a correct answer or an incorrect answer.

Options will always be presented one at a time. You may receive as few as one option for some questions and several options for other questions depending on a number of factors. Within a single question, you may see more than one correct answer option.

Response screen

Once you have responded to a question, the Response screen is displayed, listing **Your Responses** to each option presented to you.

Your **Score** on the question, which is either 100% or 0% is also displayed.

100% indicates you answered the question correctly. 0% indicates you answered the question incorrectly.

In general, you must make the correct **YES** and **NO** decisions until you are presented with all the correct answers for a question. Once you have responded correctly to all the options, including the correct answer options, the **YES/NO** decisions you make on subsequent options do not affect your score for that question.

Click the **SHOW CORRECT ANSWER** button to see the correct **Yes** and **No** decisions you should have made for the options that were presented to you

You can then compare your responses to the correct expected responses.

Show feedback

Click **SHOW FEEDBACK** to get an explanation on the options that were presented, as well as see what the correct answer or answers are.

The feedback column usually contains information about the correct answer or answers.



Note: Clicking the **SHOW CORRECT ANSWER** button once displays the correct expected responses. Clicking the same button the second time hides the correct expected responses. Similarly, clicking the **SHOW FEEDBACK** button shows the detailed list of feedback. Clicking that button for the second time hides the feedback.





Return to the Feedback Screen


Once you close the Feedback screen for a question, you can return to the feedback for that question by navigating back to that question. The Response screen for the question will display **This item is complete.**

Performance Report



Tracking your remaining attempts on a premier practice exam
