## ADDENDUM TO THE INFORMATION SECURITY DOCUMENT

(Last updated May 6, 2025)

The following terms supplement the applicable Information Security Documentation and apply to Customer's Government Moderate<sup>1</sup>, Government High and/or US Military versions of Okta's Services ("Regulated Service(s)").

### 1. System Standards.

Okta's Regulated Services are architected to align with NIST SP 800-53.

### 2. Security Authorizations.

As of the date this addendum was last updated, Okta maintains a FedRAMP Moderate and FedRAMP High Authority to Operate (ATO) for its Government Moderate and Government High Regulated Services, respectively, and a U.S. Department of Defense Impact Level 4 (IL4) Provisional Authorization to Operate (PATO) for its US Military Regulated Service. Okta intends to maintain each of the aforementioned authorizations for the Regulated Service to which such authorization applies.

### 3. Data Residency.

All Customer Data in the Regulated Services shall be stored, processed, and accessed within the continental United States of America.

### 4. Support.

Support for Regulated Services shall be provided by personnel located within the United States of America, including outlying areas as defined in the [U.S. Federal Acquisition Regulations \(FAR\) 2.101](#). Employees supporting Regulated Services are subject to additional training and policies as required by FedRAMP and DoD.

### 5. Encryption Standards.

All Customer Data shall be encrypted, in-transit and at-rest, using Federal Information Processing Standards (FIPS) modules and algorithms approved by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), e.g. AES-256.

### 6. Security Breach Management.

In addition to the security breach commitments outlined in the applicable Information Security Documentation, Okta shall report a Security Breach to Customer in accordance with applicable program requirements (e.g., FedRAMP and DoD) outlining incident communication procedures, including applicable reporting timelines.
