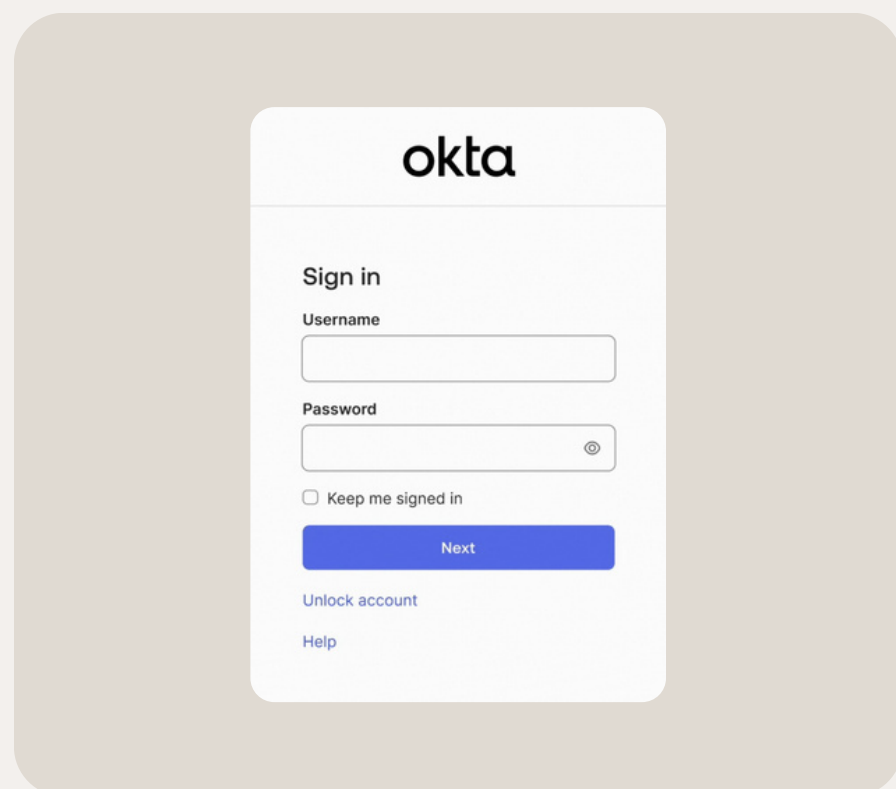

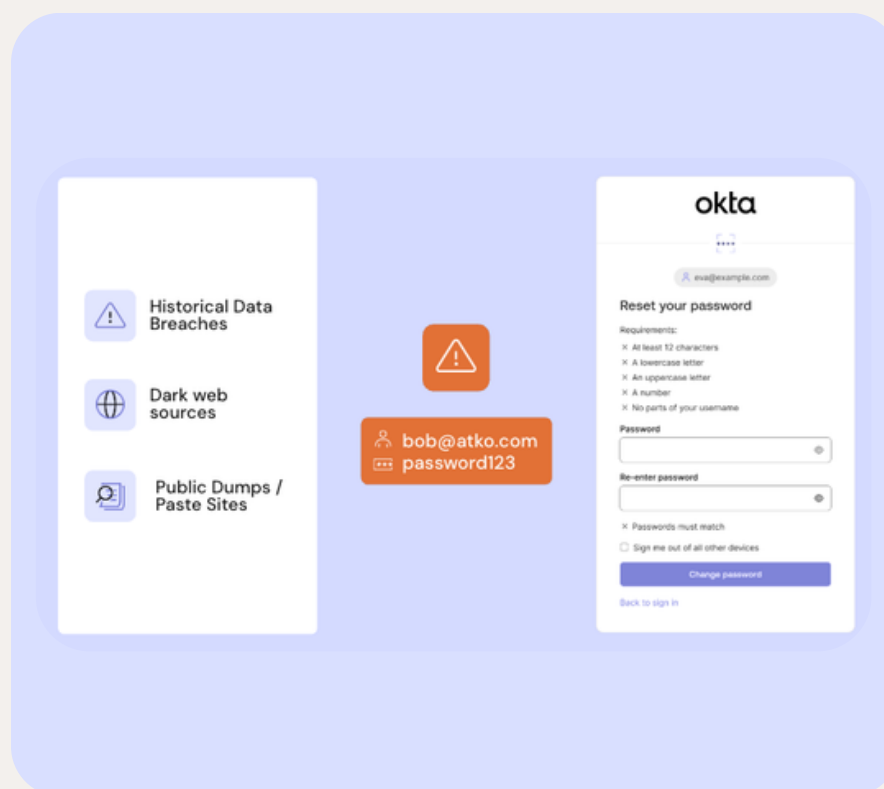

Bot Protection

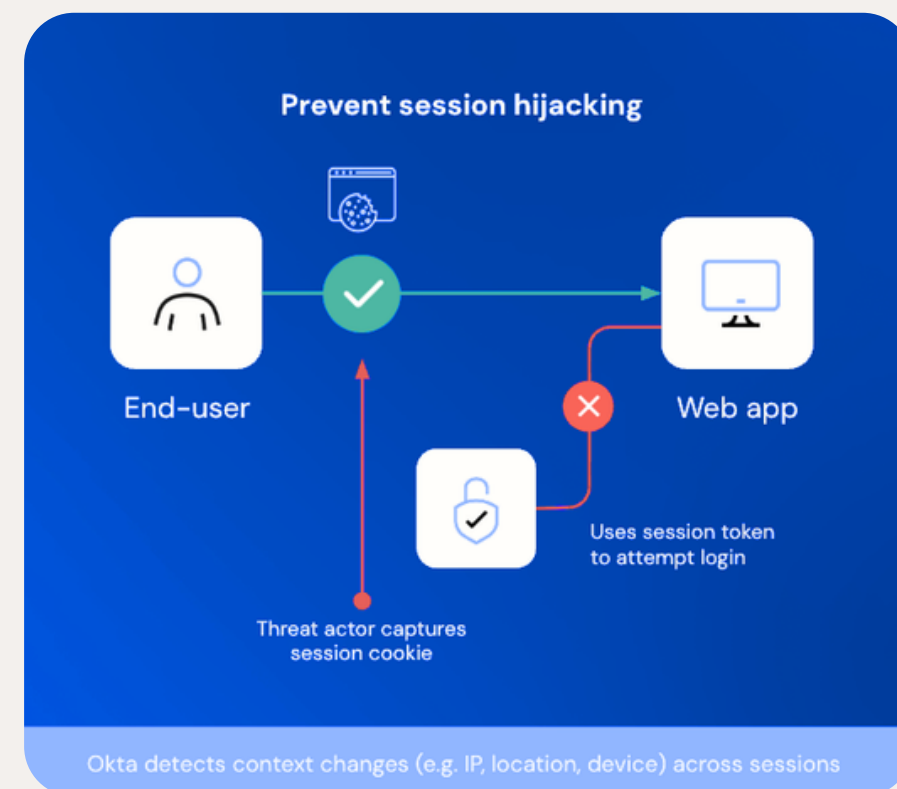

AFTER LOGIN

Prevent Session Hijacking

With over 94 billion cookies leaked last year, valid sessions are a major blind spot³. ITP continuously monitors active sessions, detecting sudden changes in IP addresses, device context, or behavior (such as Impossible Travel). When a threat is detected, instantly trigger Universal Logout to kill the compromised session(s) across all applications.
